General Statistics

1. Statistical Yearbook of Latvia 2022

The Statistical Yearbook of Latvia is the most exhaustive annual publication of statistical information on the national economy and socio-economic processes in the country. The publication reflects data on 2021, compared to previous years. The yearbook provides information on socio-political situation, economy and finance, population and social processes, sectors of national economy as well as on science and technologies. The publication contains 11 thematic chapters: Population; labour market, social security and health, education, science and culture, economy and finances, foreign trade in goods, business, information technologies, environment and weather conditions. A separate chapter is devoted to international comparisons of Latvian social and economic indicators. Information in the yearbook is compiled in tables, charts and maps, providing also explanation of the main statistical terms. The yearbook is based on the information available to the Central Statistical Bureau of Latvia and other institutions. The statistical information was obtained by conducting statistical surveys as well as by using data from public registers and other information systems.

22. Environment of Latvia in Figures: Climate Change, Natural Resources and Environmental Quality 2021

The collection of statistics presents information on environmental investment and current expenditure on protection of natural resources and environment (sample survey data), it also contains information on the emission of polluting substances into the atmosphere from stationary sources, environmental quality, greenhouse gas emissions, consumption of energy resources, natural resources and utilisation thereof (material flow accounts, resources efficiency), forestry and waste management in 2021. The indicators are comparable to the previous years and in some tables are broken down by city.

The information on air protection, environmental quality, air emissions accounts, as well as generation of municipal and hazardous waste was developed based on the data of the Latvian Environment, Geology and Meteorology Centre.
