1. Statistical Yearbook of Latvia 2023

The yearbook is the most exhaustive annual publication of statistics for the national economy and socio-economic processes. The publication contains 10 thematic chapters: geographical characteristics, population, labour market, social protection and health, education, science and culture, economy and finance, foreign trade, business, information technologies, business sectors, as well as comparative international statistics. The publication reflects data on 2022, compared to previous years. Information in the yearbook is compiled in tables, charts and maps. The yearbook is based on the information available to the Central Statistical Bureau of Latvia (obtained by conducting statistical surveys) and other institutions (data in public registers and other information systems).

Material deprivation covers conditions under which, due to the lack of financial resources, households are excluded from ordinary living patterns. The leaflet contains tables and charts, as well as a short description of indicators characterising material deprivation.

7. Veselības pašnovērtējums Latvijā 2022. gadā (Self-Perceived General Health in Latvia 2022, in Latvian)

The informative leaflet contains general health self-assessment indicators collected via annual survey *European Union Statistics on Income and Living Conditions* (EU-SILC 2022). The tables, graphs and brief description of the indicators included in the leaflet depict self-perceived general health (including chronic diseases, long-standing illnesses or health problems lasting for at least six months) of population (aged 16 and over), give information about medical care and dental visits as well as main reasons for unmet need for medical or dental examination or treatment. The indicators collected annually are supplemented with ones collected via EU-SILC 2022 ad hoc module aimed at studying population health habits, consultations with medical practitioners, financial burden of medical care, dental care and medicines, etc.

The text, tables and graphs of the collection of statistics depicts the key indicators characterising situation in agriculture in 2015, 2020 and 2022: sown areas, harvested production, yield of agricultural crops, number of livestock, animal production, organic farming, average producer prices and indices in agriculture, use of mineral and organic fertilisers, balance sheets of plant nutrients (N and P), grouping of holdings by sown area, yield of agricultural crops and number of livestock, as well as supply balance sheets of agricultural products. Some indicators are given in breakdown by statistical region and compared among Baltic countries.

Environment

23. Environment of Latvia in Figures: Climate Change, Natural Resources and Environmental Quality in 2022

The collection of statistics presents information on environmental investment and current expenditure on protection of natural resources and environment (sample survey data), emission of polluting substances into the atmosphere from stationary sources, environmental quality, greenhouse gas emissions, energy consumption, natural resources and use thereof (material flow accounts, resources efficiency), forestry and waste management in 2022. The indicators are comparable with previous years and in some tables are presented in smaller breakdown by city.

The information on air protection, environmental quality, air emissions accounts, as well as generation of municipal and hazardous waste was developed based on the data of the Latvian Environment, Geology and Meteorology Centre.
